



## John Glandfield - Director & Member Profile

John's former occupation was that of a Family Solicitor having qualified in December, 1970. Whilst he never specialised as such, much of his career was spent in both defending and prosecuting in various Magistrates Courts. John also trained and qualified as a Family Mediator. Professionally you could probably say that he has built up knowledge of how to deal with people who are in trouble. John was for many years was a Governor of Windsor Park Middle School, Uttoxeter where he ended up as Chair. He retired from that position entirely of his own accord having just started up his own business. In 1997 John was invited to join the Governors of Loxley Hall, initially as Vice-Chairman and latterly and until the Governing Body at Loxley was disbanded as an independent body, Chairman.

For some years John was Treasurer of the local Scout District and thereafter, their Auditor.
